Candidate Instructions for Universal Registration One-Time Edit Process

Universal Registration One-Time Functionality

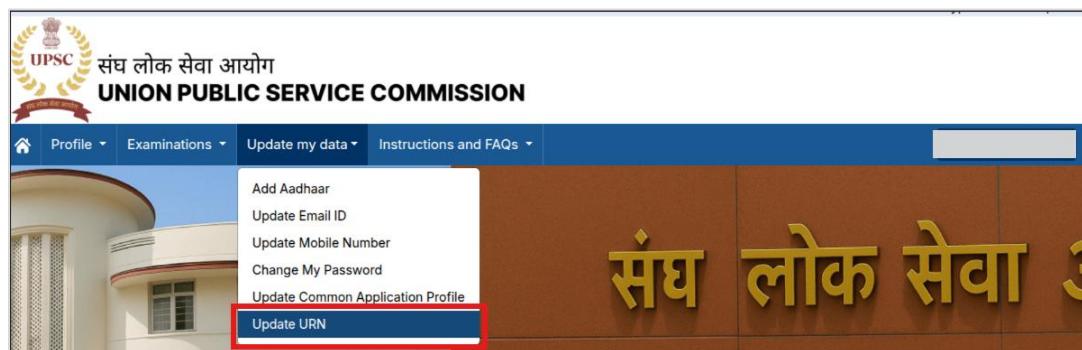
The Universal Registration Details Edit Functionality is a one-time facility provided to candidates to **correct or update** their Universal Registration details in case any incorrect information was entered earlier.

Candidates are strongly advised to use the **Universal Registration Details Edit Facility** carefully. This is a **one-time opportunity given by the UPSC** to correct any mistakes in the details already submitted. **Once the correction is done, no further changes will be allowed.**

How to Update Universal Registration Data:

1. **One-Time URN Edit Feature:** The One-Time Edit feature allows candidates to edit their Universal Registration details only once, so please make changes carefully.

2. **Steps to access the URN One-Time Edit feature:**
 - a. After logging into the candidate portal (*refer to General Instruction document for login*), click “**Update URN**” under “**Update My Data**” in the navigation bar to edit your details.



- b. The Universal Registration Preview page will open. This page shows all your existing details.

- c. Candidates are advised to **carefully review all details** shown on the preview page before proceeding further.

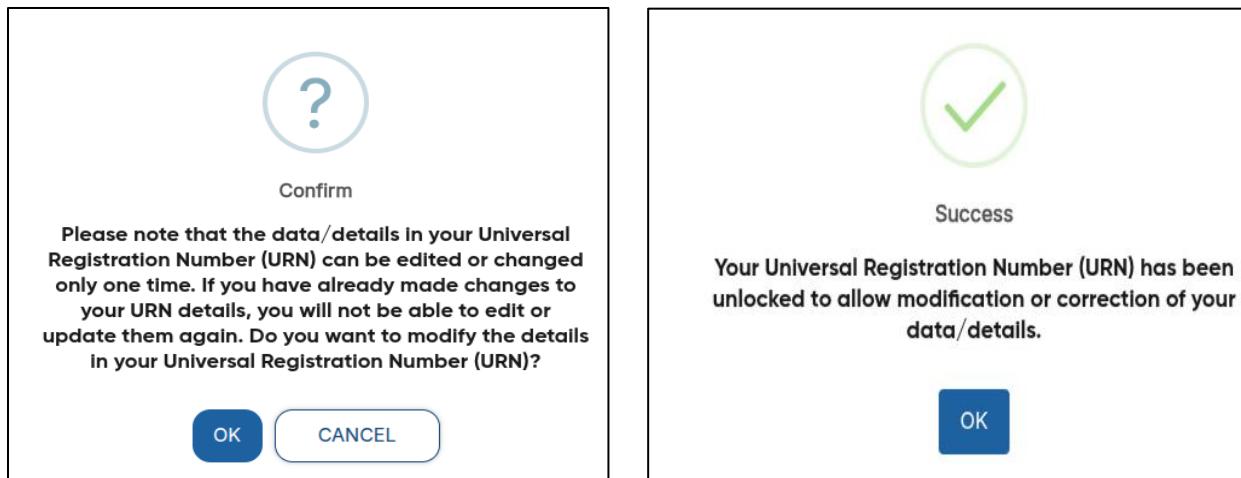

d. **Read and Accept the Mandatory Declaration:** Before editing the details, candidates must accept the following declaration:

"I want to update or modify the details in my URN account, and I understand that I will not be able to update or modify my URN details at a later stage.

e. Only after accepting the declaration can the candidate proceed to edit the details.

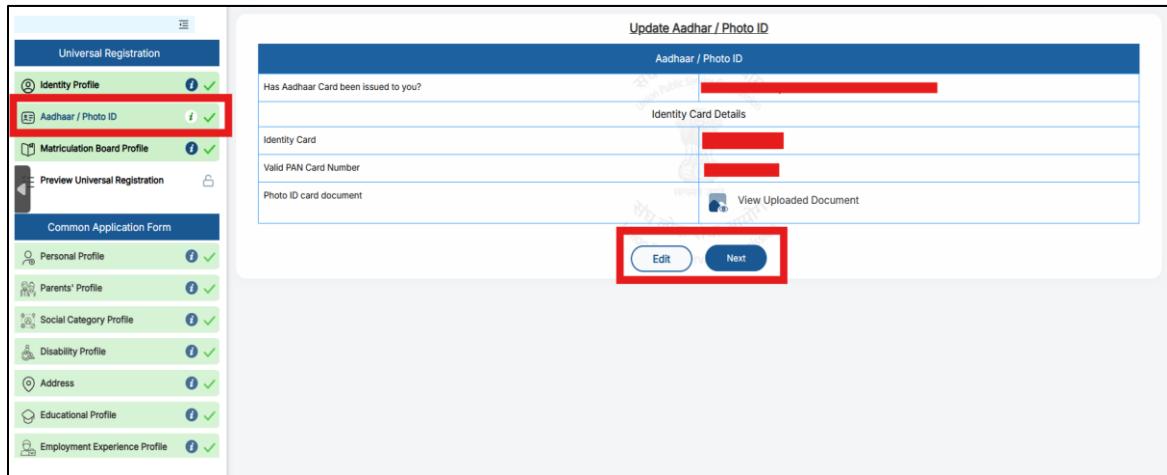


f. Sections Available for Editing:

- The URN edit module is arranged in the following sequence:
 - Identity Details
 - Aadhaar / Photo Identity Details
 - Matriculation Board Profile
 - Preview Universal Registration
- Candidates may edit the relevant details in these sections, wherever applicable.

3. Update Identity Profile – Candidate can update/edit the identity profile details.

4. Update Aadhaar/Photo ID – Candidate can update/edit the Aadhaar/ Photo ID details.

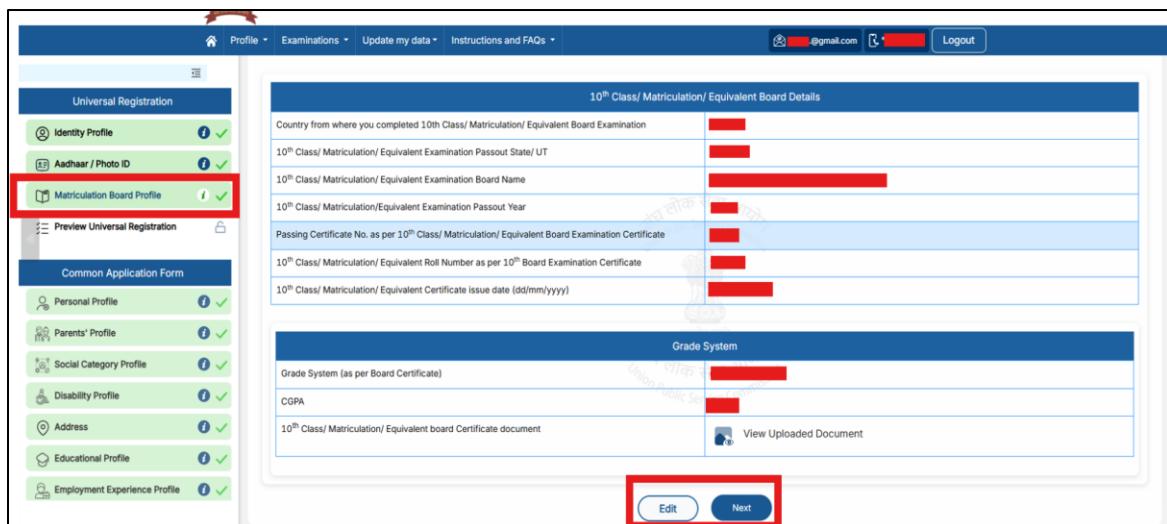

6. Make changes only if required and ensure all information is correct.

- a. A candidate can edit the Universal Registration only once.
- b. After the candidate saves and locks the Universal Registration, no further changes will be allowed.
 - i. If a candidate opens the Universal Registration edit page but does not make any changes and then closes the browser or logs out, the Universal Registration edit option will remain available.
 - ii. If the candidate's Universal Registration is not locked, the candidate will not be allowed to apply for any examination.
 - iii. All previously uploaded documents will remain available and will not be deleted.

c. The candidate must carefully verify all details before locking the Universal Registration details.

7. Preview, Lock, and Submit:

- a. After completing the required changes, candidates must review the updated details on the Preview Universal Registration page.
- b. Candidates must Lock and Submit the Universal Registration page to save the changes permanently.
- c. If the Universal Registration page is not locked, the candidate will not be permitted to apply for any examination.

8. FAQ's Section:

a. Can a candidate edit Universal registration details more than once?

Answer: No. Universal registration details edit feature allows only one edit. Once the candidate uses the “Update URN” option, further edits are not allowed.

b. What happens if a candidate opens the edit page but does not make any changes?

Answer: If the candidate closes the browser or logs out without saving, the Universal registration details edit option will not be considered used, and the one-time edit facility will remain available.

c. What happens if the Universal registration details remain unlocked after editing?

Answer: The candidate cannot apply for any examination until the Universal registration details are locked again.

d. Will my previously uploaded documents be deleted when I edit the Universal registration details?

Answer: No. All previously uploaded documents remain saved in your Universal registration details.

e. What should a candidate do if the name in the Universal registration details is different from the 10th certificate?

Answer: The system will ask whether the Universal registration details-name matches the name on the 10th certificate. If the candidate selects “No”, the system will ask whether the candidate has a Gazette Notification for the name change.

f. What happens if a candidate edits Name, Date of Birth (DoB), or Gender?

Answer: The Aadhaar / Photo ID details will be cleared automatically. The candidate must re-enter and re-verify the Aadhaar / Photo ID details.

g. Will uploaded documents be removed if the candidate edits the Universal registration details?

Answer: No. All previously uploaded documents will remain saved in the Universal registration details.
